Shiny Idea Time AKA How to Finish Stuff without Losing Your Joy

Shiny Idea Time:

Why do you want to try shiny idea time?
What time will you set aside for your shiny ideas?
Where will you put your shiny ideas so you can find them later?

Get started:

- Set a timer if it might help
- Open your idea capture system
- Pick the shiniest idea
- Start collecting words or sketches, or make notes

If you're out of ideas:

- Go for a walk
- · Do a boring task or chore
- Try something new
- Brainstorm with friends or colleagues

If you feel you don't have time:

- Try it on a different day or at a different time
- Try reframing it as a part of your process

You could also try:

- Using prompts
- Switching formats
- Using a different medium to start capturing an idea: collage, music playlists, etc.
- · Coffee shop or meetup with a fellow creative
- Special critique group session (just sharing/cheering, no feedback)
- Shiny idea time right before or after your main project time
- Secret project as a reward for main project work
- Shiny retreat for more intensive work

Project status list:

- Make a list of all your ideas
- Divide it up by project status
- Date it
- Update it periodically

Shiny Idea Time AKA How to Finish Stuff without Losing Your Joy

Main Project Time:

Choose your main project:

- · Which story do you most want to tell?
- Which story are you most excited to finish?
- Is someone expecting one of these stories?
- Which story might someone most want or need to read?

Getting another opinion:

- Pick your top three ideas
- Write a short pitch or synopsis for each
- Rewrite/polish the first 5 pages (or a selection) of each
- Share them with someone you trust (beta reader, agent, critique group)

What will your main project be?
Why are you choosing it now?
When will you work on your main project?
What will help you keep going?

To move a story from your shiny idea pile to your main project:

- Save a copy of the shiny idea
- · Copy and paste the pieces you can use into rough story order
- Make notes [in brackets] for anything you know you'll need to add
- Start filling in the blanks (in story order or not)
